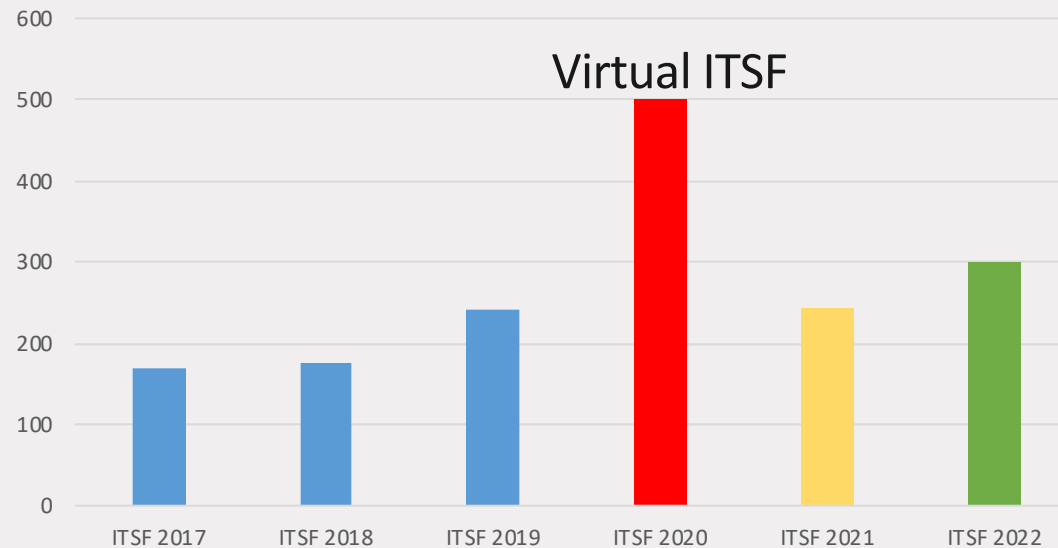

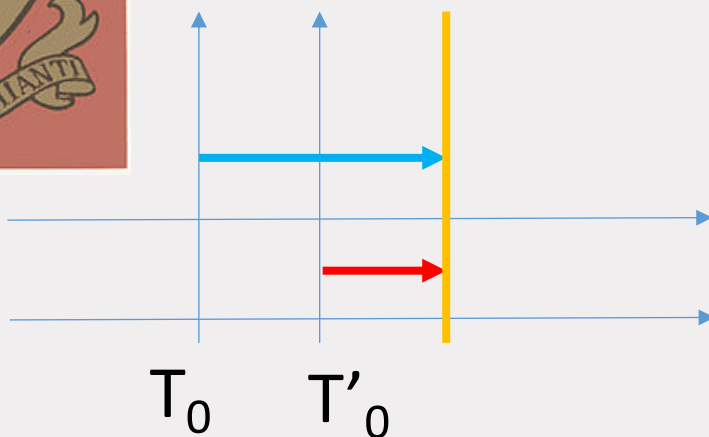

Time Sync and Black Roosters

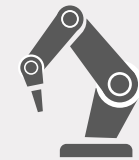

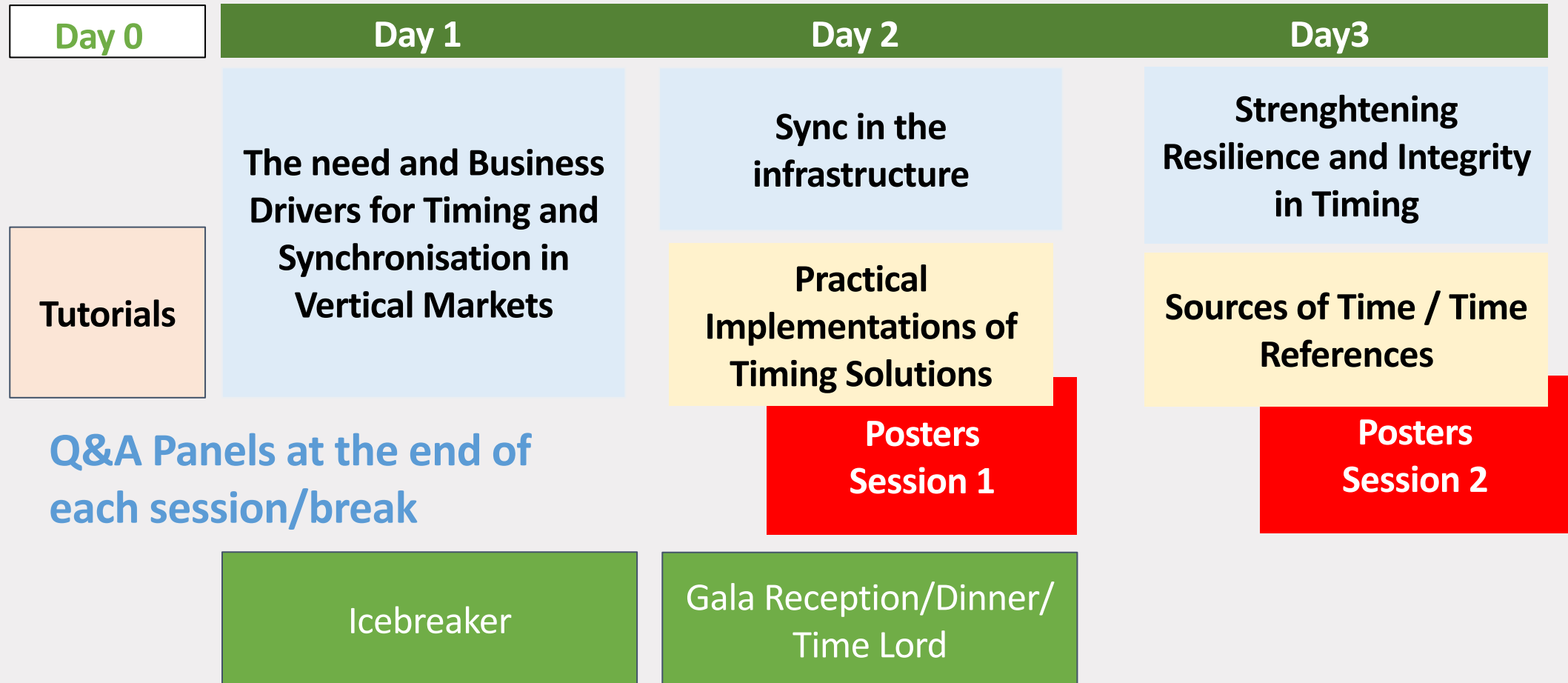
ITSF 2022: *Bringing the global timing and sync community together for the largest event of its kind in the world*

- Sync: fundamental requirement in Telecoms for many years
 - 5G deployments further raised the importance for the delivery of accurate *time synchronization* in the networks (e.g., to support TDD)
 - Evolution towards 6G will continue to set new challenges
 - Several industries and applications, Power, Industrial Automation, Automotive, Datacenter, Broadcast, Finance, increasingly acknowledged the importance of more accurate and reliable timing
- ITSF 2022:
 - New use cases and related requirements, challenges from current deployments and architectures, continuous evolution of the synchronization technology
 - Standards continuously evolving, addressing new applications, issues, and with new solutions (e.g., timing over 5G radio)

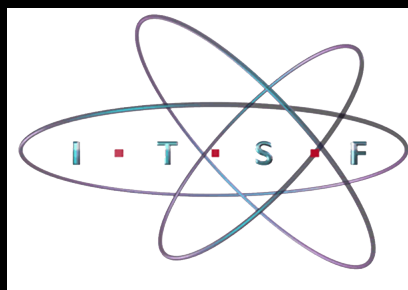
